**Press Invitation to the** 37th International Cosmic Ray Conference

On 12 July the 37th International Cosmic Ray Conference begins, the largest conference in Astroparticle Physics that is held every two years. This year it is organized by Germany as an online Conference (see the website and the program). About 1400 contributed papers have been submitted and approaching 2000 participants from all over the world have registered.

It brings together the main topics of the field: Cosmic Ray Physics, Gamma-Ray Astronomy, Neutrino Astronomy & Physics, Multi-messenger Astronomy, Dark Matter Physics, Solar & Heliospheric Physics and related Astronomy and Outreach & Education.

Broad reviews, recent scientific results, theory and modelling, experimental methods, and techniques and instrumentation will be presented. In 60 sessions selected physics topics are presented and discussed. The program is completed by a set of fringe meetings on sustainability, careers, and diversity, an Industry Fair and a Science Fair. Throughout the conference, virtual small-group meetings and conversations are possible among all participants. All presentations will be available in an archive of recorded talks and discussions, presentation slides and proceedings articles.

Thus, the ICRC 2021 will be the prime forum to learn about news and developments in Astroparticle Physics, a booming area with stunning results in the past decade, that will continue to extend our knowledge of high-energy astrophysics in the years to come with a large range of ambitious new projects.
